

Overview of Jordan Lake Rules

The State of North Carolina enacted rules to implement the Jordan Lake Nutrient Management Strategy. The “rules” (15A NCAC 02B.0262-.0273) became effective August 11, 2009, and were later modified by session laws 2009-216 and 2009-484.

Three of the strategies outlined require direct compliance by the Town of Pittsboro.

- Stormwater Rule for Existing development – In partnership with Chatham County, the Town of Pittsboro has a Stage 1 Adaptive Management Program Proposal for Existing Development.
- Stormwater Rule for New Development
- Riparian Buffer Rule

The Town is in the process of developing strategies and ordinances to comply with the requirements.
