

MATERIAL	WHAT	HOW	UNACCEPTABLE
<p>PLASTIC BOTTLES & JUGS</p> 	<p>Plastic #1 & #2 Bottles and Jugs</p>	<p>Remove caps, rinse, flatten, place in bin</p>	<p>No: Yogurt/margarine/frozen dinner trays/take out trays, plastic bags, hazardous waste (motor oil, antifreeze, etc.)</p>
<p>CANS</p> 	<p>Aluminum cans (beer, soft drink), Steel cans (food)</p>	<p>Rinse, put lids inside cans, place in bin.</p>	<p>No: Aerosol cans, paint cans, cleanser cans, cast aluminum cookware</p>
<p>Cardboard & Chipboard</p> 	<p>Corrugated cardboard & chipboard (cereal boxes, 12 pack boxes, etc.)</p>	<p>Boxes must be flattened and cardboard must be cut into 3' x 3' pieces. Place in bin.</p>	<p>No: Waxed cardboard or chipboard (Gable top juice/milk containers), pizza boxes.</p>
<p>Papers</p> 	<p>Clean, dry newspaper and inserts, magazines, phonebooks, mixed paper.</p>	<p>Remove plastic wrappers and place in bin.</p>	<p>No: Plastic wrappers/bags</p>
<p>Glass</p> 	<p>All glass food containers-clear, green, brown (amber)</p>	<p>Remove lids and rinse. Labels don't need to be removed. Place in bin.</p>	<p>No: Cookware, dishes, light bulbs, ceramics.</p>

NO Wood, Yard Waste, or Building Materials.

NO Cloth Products (clothing, shoes, towels, etc.).

NO Styrofoam Products (packing blocks & peanuts, containers, plates, or cups).
