

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING BIDS AND AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR THE
SANITARY SEWER INFILTRATION AND INFLOW (I&I) PROJECT - 2016

WHEREAS, the Town of Pittsboro has solicited formal bids by advertisement in the June 2 & 9, 2016 edition of The Chatham Record Newspaper and posted June 7, 2016 in the iSqFt Plan Room, the Dodge Data & Analytics Plan Room, and the Hispanic Contractors Association of the Carolinas (HCAC) in accordance with G.S. 143-128 for the Sanitary Sewer Infiltration and Inflow (I&I) Project – 2016.

WHEREAS, the following bids were received and opened on July 14, 2016:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF PITTSBORO:

That the Town accepts the bid of and awards the contract to the lowest responsive bidder, Herring & Rivenbark, Inc., general contractor, in the amount of \$382,293.00 for the Sanitary Sewer Infiltration and Inflow (I&I) Project - 2016, contingent upon final review and approval by the NCDEQ - Division of Water Infrastructure.

That the Town Manager is hereby authorized to execute such other documents as may be required in connection with the project.

That, because this is an improvement project of aging facility and it is expected that hidden conditions may be discovered during construction, the Town Manager is authorized to approve change orders up to a cumulative total of \$38,268.00, but not to exceed the combined total project budget of \$522,218.00, without additional Board of Commissioners action.
