

**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A DONATION OF LAND  
FROM SALISBURY PYLE, INC. IN MEMORY OF JANE PYLE**

**WHEREAS,** The Town of Pittsboro is generally authorized to accept donations of real and personal property for the benefit of its citizens, and is specifically authorized pursuant to North Carolina General Statutes 160A-353 to accept gifts for parks and recreational programs and facilities; and

**WHEREAS,** Salisbury Pyle, Inc., a North Carolina corporation desires to donate to the Town in memory of Jane Pyle a lot or parcel of land more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point where the Western right of way of Rectory Street intersects the Southern right of way of Salisbury Street in the Town of Pittsboro, and running thence from said beginning point with the southern margin of Salisbury Street 112 feet to a stake, the Northwest corner of the present Jane Pyle property; thence with Jane Pyle's line in a Southerly direction 225 feet to a point in the line of the Pittsboro Library property; thence with its line in a Westwardly direction 112 feet to a stake in the Eastern right of way of Rectory Street; thence with the Eastern right of way line of Rectory Street Northwardly 225 feet to the point and place of beginning. This is the identical property conveyed to Horton and Clara Camp by a deed from Cowan recorded in Book J-S at Page 418, Chatham County Registry, SAVE AND EXCEPT that tract previously conveyed and shown on Plat Book 97, Page 20, Chatham County Registry, which was sold separately.

**WHEREAS,** such donation is being contributed to assist the Town in the establishment of a public park or open space thereon as allowed by law, but subject to the possibility of reversion if the property is used for non-conservation purposes; and

**WHEREAS,** Jane Pyle was a long-time resident of Pittsboro and Chatham County who served this community well for many years in numerous capacities, including ten years as the only printer in town; by becoming involved with the library, planning and zoning commissions, and the Chatham County Historical Association where she contributed many well-researched articles on local history, as well as to other facets of the CCHA. Ms. Pyle also spend many hours working on the Pittsboro Historical District; and she frequently enjoyed spending time outdoors on the land that is being donated to the Town; and

**WHEREAS,** The Town Board of Commissioners finds that it is appropriate to accept said donation upon the terms and conditions offered.


