Formal bids were received at the Town of Pittsboro Conference Room for the above referenced project on July 14, 2016 at 2:00 PM. The following bids were received (see attached certified bid tabulation):

• Herring & Rivenbark, Inc.	\$382,293.00
• Atlantic Coast Contractors, Inc.	\$483,835.45
• CaJenn Construction & Rehabilitation Services, Inc.	\$487,657.00
• Step Construction, Inc.	\$498,465.84
• VacVision Environmental, LLC	\$511,411.25
• Layne Inliner, LLC	\$544,840.00

The construction cost estimate for this project prepared by Hydrostructures, P.A. was \$382,675.00.

NC Department of Environmental Quality – Division of Water Infrastructure must review the bid package and other pertinent / requested information to issue the Town of Pittsboro an “Authority to Award”. Included in the requested information must be a resolution of tentative award issued by the Board of Commissioners.

Herring & Rivenbark, Inc. works in the field of sewer rehabilitation and has completed a project that Hydrostructures designed for the City of Goldsboro. Hydrostructures has also worked with one of their Project Managers on a sewer rehabilitation project for the City of Raleigh and they completed the job professionally. Their bid package included a bid bond and appeared to include appropriate minority / women business enterprise documents. Therefore, Hydrostructures recommends that the project be awarded (tentatively) to Herring & Rivenbark, Inc. in the amount of \$382,293.00 contingent on the Division of Water Infrastructure’s review and acceptance of the bid package.
