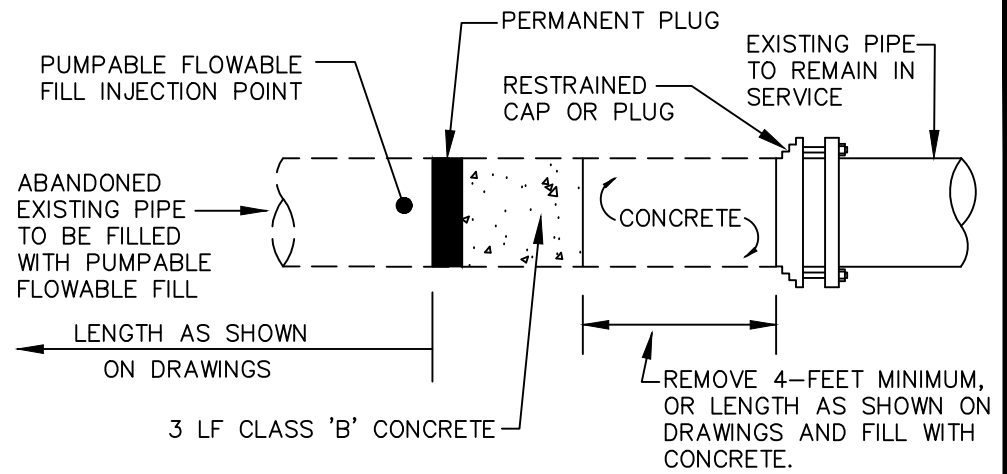
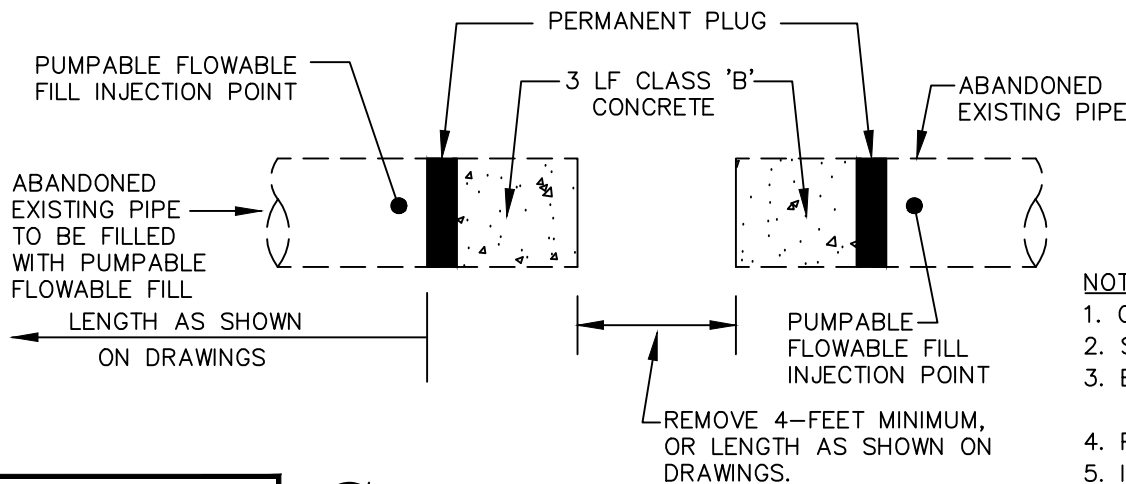


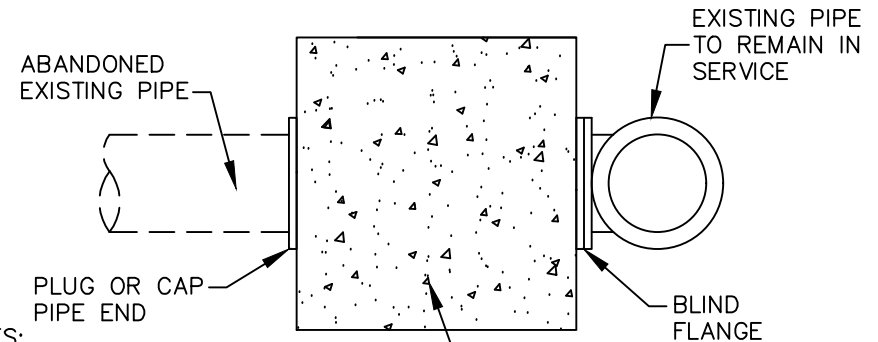
A. TYPICAL CUT AND PLUG
