Town Code Enforcement Operations

Code Enforcement involves a wide range of issues. The Town's Code Enforcement efforts are handled through the Planning Office and other County, State, and Federal regulatory agencies as may be required. The Town's regulations are cited in the Code of Ordinances (the Town Code), the Subdivision Ordinance, and the Zoning Ordinance.

Typical items that are addressed are listed below and are regulated by Chapters 11, 12, and 13 of the Town Code;

1. Abandoned, Nuisance, and Junked Motor Vehicles.
2. Overgrown Lots
3. Old Furniture
4. Trash
5. Junk
6. Tires
7. Appliances
8. Building Materials

Other items that are addressed by the Town's Zoning Ordinance are listed below;

1. Construction without a Building Permit
2. Construction without a Zoning Permit.
3. Sign Regulations
4. Operating a Business in a Residential Zoning District

The following items are referred to and addressed by other agencies:

1. Noise within the Corporate Limits – Town of Pittsboro Police Department
2. Noise outside the Corporate Limits – Chatham County Sheriff's Office
3. Animal Control – Chatham County Animal Control Services
4. Well and Septic Problems – Chatham County Environmental Health
5. Illegal Burning – Chatham County Fire Marshall
