Separate sealed BIDS for the construction of **Priority Sewer Rehabilitation Project - 2016** will be received by the Town of Pittsboro until **2:00 p.m. Eastern Standard Time, July 14, 2016** and then publicly opened and read aloud in the Conference Room at Town Hall.

The work consists of the following approximate major items:

- Install approximately 3,386 linear feet of cured-in-place pipe lining for 8-inch sewer mains.
- Install approximately 1,116 linear feet of cured-in-place pipe lining for 10-inch sewer mains.
- Replacement of approximately 25 service laterals via open-cut.
- Replacement of approximately 36 cleanout caps & stacks.
- Complete rehabilitation of 3 manholes (approximately 31 vertical feet) using calcium aluminate cementitious mortar. Miscellaneous repairs on approximately 20 manholes including grout injection, replacing covers, etc.
- Perform other associated work including asphalt cutting and patching, flow control, & site restoration.
